Sub : Technical Education – Admission to UG / PG Degree Courses  
– 2014-15 – Fee to be collected from students – reg.

The details of fee prescribed by the Committee on Fixation of fee in respect of Self-Financing Professional Colleges for the years 2011-12 to 2014-15 are given in the Annexure.

The Principals of all Self-Financing Engineering Colleges are requested to collect only the applicable fee after proper deductions as noted below:

For students admitted prior to 2014-15 (II, III and IV year Students)

1. Tuition fee concession for First Generation Graduates – Rs.20,000/-

For students admitted during 2014-15

1. Tuition fee concession for First Generation Graduates – Rs.20,000/-
2. Initial payment paid by the student at the time of Counselling (Rs.5,000/- for General and Rs.1,000/- for SC/SCA/ST)

Centrally assisted Adi-Dravida Scholarship Scheme:

For students belonging to SC/SCA/ST Communities and students converted to Christianity who are eligible under the Centrally assisted Post Matric Scholarship Scheme (PMSS) (i.e. annual parental income is less than 2.5 lakhs in respect of SC/SCA/ST students and annual parental income is less than Rs.2.0 lakhs for Adi-Dravida students converted to Christianity) no fee should be collected from the student as per provisions in G.O. (Ms.) No.6, Adi Dravida and Tribal Welfare (ADW-3) Department, dated 9.1.2012.

Any complaint received regarding excess fee collection will be referred to Committee to enquire and inspect Educational Institutions on Fee for necessary action.
