Introduction: Nelson Mandela once famously said,

“Education is the most powerful weapon which you can use to change the world.”

In order to bring about this change through education, the management of St. Britto's Academy undertook a new initiative and decided to incorporate leadership principles illustrated in the book “The Leader in Me” by Stephen R. Covey during the academic year 2018-19 by Live Life Education. In this venture, the first step was to train the faculty and staff to see themselves and others as effective leaders and as the channels of change. So, an orientation was conducted in order to bring about a paradigm shift in leadership. This lively session also enabled the participants to know how to implement the language of “The Seven Habits of Highly Effective People”.

Theme of the Day : The Leader In Me **Conducted by**: Dr. Kannan Gireesh & Team
(Live Life Education Private Limited)

Participants : Principal, Vice-Principals, SBA Teaching Staff



On the first day, the staff of SBA were divided into groups and discussions were initiated on leadership, effectiveness of being a leader and the common paradigms.

The five highly effective paradigms of leadership, potential, change, motivation and education were described. These were interspersed with short captivating videos. Dr. Kannan Gireesh stimulated the groups to come up with their own 'team name' and a 'motto', based on which he conducted peppy games, which helped the teachers to develop their audio-visual and kinesthetic skills. In the afternoon session, Dr. Kannan introduced the Seven Habits with actions. The first habit, "Be proactive", was explained. The positivity of using proactive language in everyday conversation was stressed upon.

On 4th April, Dr. Kannan Gireesh led the groups through the remaining Six Habits. Based on the second habit, "Begin with the end in mind", each of the members was motivated to form his/her own personal mission statement. A short video was displayed to explain the third habit, "Put first things first", followed by a group discussion, which helped in prioritizing the duties. The fourth habit, "Think win-win" was instilled into the minds of the faculty through an energetic game. A related case study taught the importance of having an 'abundance mentality' and considering other's wins before one's own. The listening skills of the participants were then tested through small games and group activities, in keeping with the fifth habit, "Seek first to understand, then to be understood". In the afternoon session, the facilitator continued with the sixth habit, "Synergize", through another game, which inculcated the principles of creativity, cooperation, diversity and humility. Finally, the seventh habit, "Sharpen the saw" was highlighted. It means investing in oneself by regularly renewing the body, mind, heart and spirit in order to maintain balance in life.

On the third day, the morning session was a continuation of the seventh habit, "Sharpen the saw", in which Dr. Kannan Gireesh guided the groups through an emotional cleansing. Each group had a sharing time, followed by laughter therapy, which refreshed the minds and helped sharpen the saws of all the participants. In the afternoon of 5th April and on the morning of 6th April, Ms. Jeba, one of the members of Live Life Education, led the staff through the process and implementation of "The Leader In Me" for a whole-school transformation. They were taught how to create a leadership culture, align academic systems and to teach leadership principles through various methods. On the final day, certificates were awarded to the participants.

Dr. Nappinnai Seran's Speech – A Compilation



“A parent is a teacher at home and a teacher is a parent in school and the child is the centre of our universe.”

Bringing school and parents together, improves academic and social success for children. Having this end in mind

a Orientation Programme was organized for the parents of KG-II.

The programme commenced with a warm welcome to the Chief Guest Dr. Nappinnai Seran, a renowned Psychologist in Chennai. Our Principal Mrs. Mary Vasantha Kumari, addressed the gathering by giving a small introduction about the Chief Guest and the programme.

Dr. Nappinnai Seran, in her speech gave guidelines about effective parenting. She also suggested different measures to nurture a child with love, care and to build a strong foundation for a glorious future.

The parents were briefed on “**How to handle kids**” through Practice, Experience and Secret Ingredients.

Why “Secret Ingredients” are required?

Parents who are over involved in their kid's activities do not

- Let the child to explore, do his / her work.
- Allow the child to question.
- Give contradictory signs (do the work fast/please have patience)

All of the above stated points will bring down the confidence and self esteem level in the child.

- Teach the child how to be Independent by allowing the child to do his / her work.

- Allow the child to ask questions.
- Think from the perspective of the child.
- Don't influence the child negatively.
- Spending quality time with them.
- Being more interactive.

Secret Ingredient No.1 – Talking to child

Give the child 5 mins or more to talk on his/her own about anything by giving his/her own personal space.

- Do not be judgmental.
- Listen calmly without interrupting.
- Stay calm.

Secret Ingredient No.2 - Looking at the child

- Look at the child when he is talking. It enhances the child's confidence.
- Give less importance to gadgets.

Types of parents

- **Authoritative and Authoritarian**

Authoritative Parents - Listen what I say, I know better, you don't tell me.

- Here, the child's self esteem is demeaned.
- Child loses self-confidence.
- Child will go out to explore and try to do everything to make himself/herself happy.

Authoritarian Parents

Secret Ingredient No.3 – Reason out to the child

- Here, the parent explains why the child has to do a particular thing, tells the child about the value, about studies, confidence and responsibility.
- Parents tell the child to help others, be a good human being, take care of the elders.

Child mimics parents, so tell or talk to child and reason out.

This helps in instilling the responsibility; confidence and “I can do” feeling.

Punitive parents – punishing parents

- For not eating
- For not doing homework
- For not obeying
- Here, the child learns to tell lie, becomes manipulative, hides his/her mistakes due to fear of punishment.

What to do?

- Check why the child is not eating, check his/her appetite, do creative cooking.
- Check why he/she is unable to do the homework.

Secret Ingredient No.4 – Make the child realize responsibility

- Tell the child to play and put back the toys.
- Assign small house-hold chores.
- Make the child part of the family, by giving small responsibilities to discharge.

Secret Ingredient No.5 – Encourage the child

- Stop comparing the child with others.
- Encourage child to talk, ask questions, some times can criticize what parents do also, let



child learn criticism.

- Don't criticize a child that he/she is incapable or incompetent.

Uninvolved Parents

- Not taking care of the child
- Not knowing kids class
- Not knowing child's taste
- No connection between parents and the kids
- Not knowing the trauma what the child is undergoing

Child feels less liberty to talk to the parents, fearing punishment, rejection and criticism. Abused kids will not revert back to the parents.

What to do?

- Teach the child good touch and bad touch
- Be supportive to the child
- Make the child feel confident to tell anything, anytime to the parents.

Secret Ingredient No.6 – Instill the confidence that I am there

- Support the child
- Spend time with them
- Make the child realize their mistake.
- See to it that they don't repeat the mistakes.
- Don't try to compensate your love with monetary gifts.
- Communicate to the child what you are feeling or going to do for him/her.

What is child Abuse?

- Touching the private parts
- Emotional abuse
- Asking the child to watch pornography
- Asking the child to touch the private parts in return

- Taking a picture of the child
- Threatening the child if it discloses about the abuse to parents or elders.
- Happens only with known people (like family, friends, neighbors etc.)

What to do or how to tell the child?

- Tell the child to oppose strongly when it is being involved in child abuse.
- Teach the child not to touch someone unless and until the parents are with him or her.
- Teach the child defense.
- Teach the child to be aggressive if somebody is abusing him/her.
- Teach the child to say “No”.
- Teach the child to come and tell parents what’s happening around him/her.

What is demeaning the child?

- Telling the child that he/she does not know anything. (You don’t know anything or cannot do anything)

How to handle?

- Teach the child to accept rejection.
- Tell the child that you will teach the child if someone says that he/she does not know anything.
- Teach healthy competition between the kids, you can do it.
- Teach the child 50-50.

Value of Food

- Teach the child to share and eat.
- Teach the child the value of food.
- Tell the child about people who don’t have food to eat.
- Tell the child not to waste.
- Teach the child on health aspects.
- Teach child the importance of Nutritious food.

How is the memory of a child damaged?

- Watching TV, Cell phone, Tabs etc.
- Radiations are bad to the brain.
- Nomo phobia is the irrational fear of being without phone.

How can we improve memory?

- By constant practice.
- By reading books.
- Retiring to the bed early.

All the above keeps our memory improved.

Secret Ingredient No.7 – Encouraging child to do activities.

- Ask the child to draw or write story.
- Sit with the child while doing activities.
- Teach child the necessity of gadgets, but also teach them that they are not of primary importance.
- Keep rules and follow them strictly.
- More the screen time, less the sleep time, less the sleep time, more the psychological problem.
- Avoid talking negatively. (Use words like you can do, we will help you out, etc.)

What to do when the second child is expected?

- Don't tell the child that the mother will come with a baby once she goes into the hospital.
- Never make the first child feel less important than the second child.
- Sibling rivalry can be avoided by involving the child in the entire pregnancy period.
- Be truthful to the child, tell the fact.
- Involve first child once pregnancy is confirmed.
- Prepare the first child to receive the new born.

- Tell the child how baby is growing in the womb.
- Tell the child that it's a blessing from god.
- Show the pictures to the first child and tell the child that it looked the same when it was in the womb.
- Prepare the child to take care of the new born.
- Ask the first child to help mother once the new born arrives home.
- Teach the child to share things with the new born.

Question & Answer Session

1. How to handle peer influence?

- Talk to the child.
- Ask the child what is right or wrong.
- Explain the child why it is wrong and tell the consequences.
- Encourage and give liberty to the child to share or ask anything by assuring that parents will not mistake the child.

2. To what extent the father can speak to a girl child as their age progresses?

- Parents should be open with the child when they come to speak.
- Parents should feel free to speak anything without discrimination of gender.
- The child will choose either of the parents based on the comfort level.

3. How to inculcate the habit of eating on its own?

- Make the child to eat from age 2.
- Start with small portion and gradually increase the portions.

4. How to improve memorizing?

Reasons could be...

- Not knowing the concept.
- Not understanding the concept.
- Not revising.

- Parents have to find out the difficulty with the child in memorizing.

5. How to handle hyper active child who doesn't sit in one place?

- Meet a psychiatrist. He will evaluate the child and tell whether medication or therapy is to be given.

If treatment

- Child will be taught to focus with medication.

If therapy

- Put the child in any of the games swimming, boxing, running, table tennis, etc.
- Drain the child's energy.

6. How to handle a child who is close to grand parents?

- Draw a line. Tell grand parents that when a parent (mother / father) is correcting the child they should not come in between.
- Don't correct the child in front of the grand parents.
- Talk to the child in strict tone.
- Involve a psychiatrist who can explain to grand parents how much their behavior is affecting their grand child.

7. How to improve the listening skills?

- Check the attention span.
- Outsource for studies.

8. Child who is active at home is not active in school?

- Need not do anything.
- Let the child evolve on it's own.

9. How to handle a tantrum child?

- Ignore if the child is crying or not eating.
- It is okay if the child is throwing tantrum in public place, just ignore.

10. How to handle a kid who parent is working?

- Do not over power the child.
- Outsource maid for household chores.
- Spend time with the child and eradicate the fear of abandoning the child.

11. How to handle sibling rivalry?

- Involve the child in caring and when dressing the second child.
- Keep the first child closer when the mother is nursing the second child.
- Mother's warmth should be substituted equally.
- Make the child feel that he/she is also equally important in the family.

12. How to avoid neighbors and others instilling rivalry in kids mind?

- Cannot change anything (like neighbors, family members etc.)
- Give confidence to the child that he/she can do better.

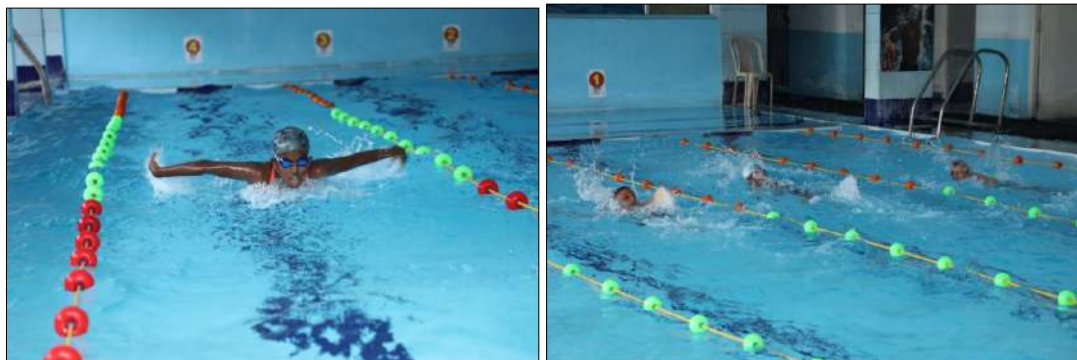



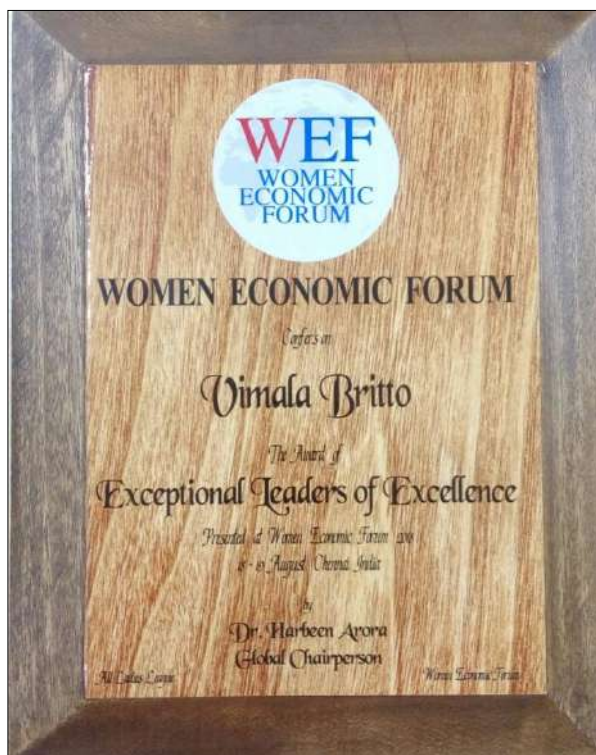
